### Webinar on Research and Publication Ethics organized



A webinar on "Strengthening Research Quality and Integrity: Publication Ethics and Ethical Dilemmas" was organized by Girijananda Chowdhury University, Guwahati in collaboration with MoU Implementation Cell, Sarupathar College on 2<sup>nd</sup> May, 2024. A total of 3ti faculty members of Sarupathar College, Barpathar College, Bokajan College, Mariani College and Eastern Karbi Anglong College participated in the webinar. The webinar started with the welcome address delivered by Dr. Moytri Sarmah, MoU Co-ordinator of Girijananda Chowdhury University. Dr. Nirmala Devi, Associate Professor of Chemistry, Girijananda Chowdhury University graced the occasion as resource person. Addressing the participants, Dr. Devi Said, "Research integrity is an essential precept of scientific inquiry and discovery which comprises norms such as Rigor, Reproducibility, and Responsibility." She observed that over the past decades, numerous issues have arisen that challenge the reliability of scientific studies, including irreproducibility crises, lack of good scientific principles, and erroneous communications, which have impacted the public's trust in science and its findings. Dr. Devi highlighted the important components of research integrity that are often overlooked in the discussion of proposals for improving research quality and promoting robust research. She also outlined the role of education and institutions of higher education in teaching the tenets of good scientific practice and within that, the importance of adequate communications training. "Universities and other research performing organizations are the cradle of competence, knowledge, and curiosity, playing a pivotal role in society by informing social, political, and economic decision-making", Dr. Devi said. The webinar came to an end with the vote of thanks offered by Mr. Pranjal Dutta, Co-ordinator, MoU Implementation Cell, Sarupathar College. ■

**World Anti Tobacco Day Observed**



With an aim to raise awareness about the harmful effects of tobacco use and to advocate for effective policies to reduce consumption of tobacco, the Anti Tobacco Cell in collaboration of IQAC, Sarupathar College organized an awareness programme on 31<sup>st</sup> May, 2024 in the digital conference hall of the college. In this connection a meeting was convened today under

the chairmanship of Dr. Rita Kumari Bora, Vice Principal of the college. The purpose of the meeting was explained by Mr. Satyabrata Dutta, Co-ordinator of the Anti-Tobacco Cell of the College.
